However, if you have tried using the new site and have experienced technical difficulties, there may be some simple things you can do to improve your experience.

We've compiled a list of common problems and their fixes:





Update your browser

This is a simple fix that is fast, easy, and free! Check what version your browser is currently running on before updating. Also make sure that your Java Script is enabled in your browser, which allows a pop-box to prompt you when a new update is available (see item 3 for instructions).



Symptoms include:

- Pages that don't fully load or come out jumbled
- Search results that come out blank
- Input boxes that do not let you type anything

Make sure that "cookies" are enabled

Unfortunately, this doesn't have anything to do with actual cookies of the chocolate chip variety. A cookie is a tiny piece of information from a website that your computer holds on to. When you return to our website, that cookie is recognized, prompting the site to hold-off on showing you any messages that you have already seen.



Symptoms include:

Excessive pop up messages that appear every time you log in.

Enable Javascript

Frames Data Online runs on Java Script, a coding method used in website development. For full functionality, Java Script on your browser needs to be enabled to run the site's features.



Symptoms Include:

- Search results that come out blank
- Trouble logging in after entering username and password
- A Warning appears on the Frames Data homepage
